## Golf Course News is All Good!!

**A**s the weather begins to cooperate and warm up, we are quite busy on the golf course. **Drainage** has been installed in the greens on holes #2, 3, 4, 5 & 9. Now all nine greens in play have internal drainage which allows us to maintain **healthier turf** and limit course closing times dues to heavy rainfall. The remaining **tree trimmings** as recommended by the Greens Committee and approved by the Arbor Committee were completed during the last week in April. The stumps have been ground down and grass will be planted in those locations. Kentucky Bluegrass sod has been laid on the left side of #2 green and will remain closed until it takes root into the ground. Please do not attempt to walk on it as it will slide on the hillside.

It took a very long time for the some of our grasses to break out of dormancy this year, but now I am hopeful the **cold temperatures are behind us** and we can continue to progress and have a wonderful summer. If you have any questions or comments, please don't hesitate to ask and **please remember to fix your ball marks and fill or replace your divots!!!**
